Chrissie professed a hope in Christ at an early age at Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church.

Chrissie grew up in Springfield, TN, attending Robertson County Schools where she was a graduate of Springfield High School graduating with the class of 1990. While at Springfield High, she was an outstanding basketball player, becoming one of the most dominant players in Springfield High School basketball history. Chrissie played for the Yellow Jackets from 1986-1990, earning numerous accolades during her time at SHS. Chrissie's basketball jersey #42, is one of only two jerseys retired in the program. She was inducted into the Springfield High School Hall of Fame in 2021. Chrissie signed with Belmont out of high school and later forged a hall of fame career as a Rebelette. She still holds the school records for points, rebounds and made field goals as well as single season records for made field goals and field goal percentage. Chrissie became the only third player

in Belmont history to have her jersey #40 retired in 1996. She was inducted into the Hall of Fame for Belmont in 2002. Chrissie remains a member of the all time starting five for Belmont. Chrissie graduated from Belmont in 1995 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Education. She also obtained a certificate as a medical assistant.

Chrissie was a faithful team member at Lowe's Distribution in Pleasant View, TN.

Chrissie was a loving mother, sister, and friend to so many. She was a member of the Future Foxes many years ago. Chrissie always greeted anyone she met with a smile.

Chrissie is preceded in death by her mother, Faye C. Dunn; daughter, Jalyn C. Payne; grandparents, Louise and Felix Moseley, Roscoe Dunn and Velma Polk; uncles, Robert and Mark Moseley and devoted friend, Lavonnia Bigbee.
